A County Durham man caught walking his Lurcher dog through the window of his moving car has lost his licence. The 23 year old admitted breaching two counts of the Road Traffic Act, at Magistrates Court. Police caught the man driving his car with the dog lead attached through the window.

Magistrates fined the man a total of £124 and gave him three penalty points; as he already had nine points on his licence, he was disqualified from driving for six months in mitigation, his solicitor, said: "He accepts it was a silly thing to do, borne out with an element of laziness."
