# Thought for the week

Titus 1:2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

Documents suggesting that Boy Scout founder Lord Baden-Powell illegally executed a prisoner-of-war have been sold for £3,740. Papers relating to the Second Matabele War in 1896 say Baden-Powell, then a Colonel in the British Army, ordered the shooting of an African chief. The chief, Uwini, had been promised his life would be spared if he surrendered. An inquiry at the time of the conflict into the affair exonerated Baden-Powell.

However, the inquiry papers, which were originally owned by his commanding officer, Sir Frederick Carrington, made it clear that the future scouting leader knew Uwini had been promised safe conduct for surrender. Chief Uwini had led a rebellion by Africans against a white settlement in what is now Zimbabwe. Robin Clay, Baden-Powell's grandson, told The Times newspaper: "We all make mistakes. In time of war emotions are aroused and you do what you think at the time."

When God makes a promise we can be absolutely sure that it will be honoured. The bible tells us that "God cannot lie". When a sinner comes in repentance and receives the Lord Jesus as their Saviour they are promised complete forgiveness from sin and eternal life in heaven. That is why the true Christian has complete assurance of heaven at the moment of death. If you are still trusting in something that offers nothing only a hope so or a maybe; then come to Christ and you will know for sure that you have eternal life and a place in heaven for eternity.

Dear friends,

Thanks for your prayers in these days in Barcelona. I have had several opportunities to teach in some Good News Clubs. The children have been very receptive and have listened well. Yesterday it snowed in Barcelona for the first time in 25 years. The city came to a standstill. There wasn't a single bus running and many roads were cut off. People had to abandon their cars and find shelter for the night in some places. Thankfully I was working from home and had a great view of the snow from the 5th floor apartment where I am staying.

Today (Tuesday) life in the city has gotten back to normal. Here are some things to pray for over the next couple of weeks.

1. Traveling to Madrid 18th, 19th, 20th March for two training days. Not too many people have signed up yet so please pray that there would be some more who will sign up in the next couple of weeks. I will be responsible for teaching two classes. One is on prayer and the other is on missions. Pray for clarity as I teach that they would understand me and that the Lord would challenge the people and encourage them in their ministry with children.

2. I am also preparing for a camp which will be held from 27th-31st March. I will miss the last day as I will be coming back home on 31st. I am responsible the other three days for the Bible lesson for the 9-11 years group. Pray for me as I prepare for that and that many of the children who come would come to know the Saviour. This Saturday 13th March we have a day with all the camp counselors to prepare for the camp.

At the moment most of my time is taken up with preparation and other wee jobs around the office here. Thanks to all of you who have texted and who have been praying for me. I have been missing my Clubs back home. Please do continue to pray for Newbuildings, Ballykelly and Drumachose. I had a message to say that one of the little girls in the Newbuildings Club told her Mum that she had trusted the Lord.
